### Abstract Submission

An abstract of 200-300 words (including bibliography) should be submitted by April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 in .doc format via e-mail to [siedlceforum@gmail.com](mailto:siedlceforum@gmail.com). Your abstract must be accompanied by the following information: **name of the author, title of paper, affiliation, academic degree, research area, a biographical note of 60-80 words in length**. Notification of acceptance will be sent by April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

### Conference Proceedings

After the conference, the articles will be published in a peer-reviewed volume. The articles need to be submitted by August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019.
